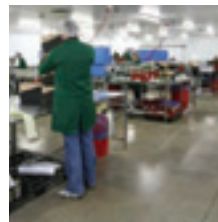
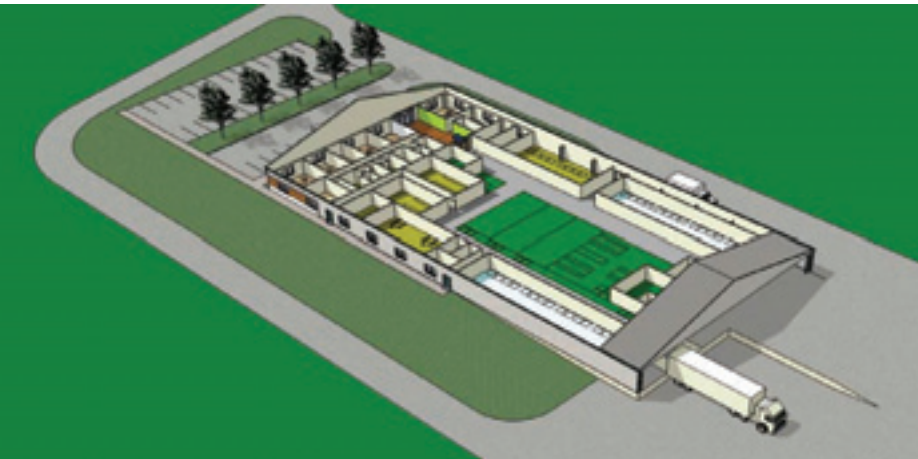


New Production Facility
